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AGREEMENT FOR EMPLOYMENT TO OPERATE A BUSINESS OF A PHARMA CIST

This Agreement is made on this 23 (lay of September 2024
BETWEEN
(hereinafter referred to as the PROPRIETOR) the expression which includes his assignees, agents or his legal representative of his business.
AND
who supervises a business of a pharmacist (herein: fter referred to as the SUPERINTENDENT).
WHEREAS the Proprietor wishes to establish and operate a business of a pharmacist which is a regulated business under the Act
WHEREAS in compliance with section 43 of the Act the Proprietor wishes to engage the professional services of a pharmacist to be in charge of his business,
WHEREAS the Superintendent is willing to offer professional services to the proprietor in lieu of remuneration for such services or such other terms and conditions as stipulated hereunder;
WHEREAS the proprietor and superintendent are desirous to enter into an agreement, to establish and operate a business of a pharmacist at the terms and conditions as hereinafter appearing;
WHEREAS the Parties agree to establish and operate a business of a pharmacist styled asPharmacy.
AND NOW WHEREFORE THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS;
Interpretation:
"Act" means the Pharmacy Act, Cap 311.
"Agreement" means the Agreement between the parties to establish and operate a business of Pharmacist.
"Business of pharmacy or pharmaciet" includes a fine include.
"Business of pharmacy or pharmacist" includes professional pharmacy practice and any activity carried on by a person in relation to medicines, medical devices or herbal medicines;
'Pharmacy" means any approved premises where in or from which any services pertaining to he practice of a pharmacist is provided, and shall include a community Pharmacy, consultant Pharmacy or wholesale Pharmacy.
'Proprietor" means an owner of Pharmacy and includes his assignees, agents or his legal
Superintendent" means a pharmacist in charge of the business of a pharmacist

- 4.1.10 Shall ensure availability of all necessary reference and other relevant materials necessary for provision of pharmaceutical services and operations.
- 4.1.11 Shall report to the Pharmacy Counc I on poor attendance, service provided or malpractices done by the Superintender t.
- 4.1.12 Shall purchase and ensure availability of all necessary tools for pharmacy operations are in place, i.e Superintendent log book, PC logo, dispensing register, ledgers etc.
- 4.1.13 Shall not interfere with the performance of professional matters in the premises or cause non-performance of professional services in the pharmacy.
- 4.1.14 Shall ensure all purchases or procurement and deliverables of pharmacy items are signed by a superintendent.
- 4.1.15 Perform any other duty as the Council m ay determine from time to time.

4.2 The Superintendent;

At a salary or emolument stipulated in clause 4.1.1 of this Agreement, the Superintendent shall, with all commitment and professional diligence, take the necessary steps to establish and efficiently supervise the said plarmacy, dealing in Pharmaceuticals.

The superintendent shall have the following duties and obligations: -

- 4.2.1 Shall obtain from the Pharmacy Council and other appropriate authorities collect the requisite licenses, permits and authorization and keep the pharmacy within the standards and conditions as contained in any written law that regulate and control the business of a pharmacist.
- 4.2.2 Shall ensure physical supervision of the said premises at a minimum of 15 hours in 7 days of the week. Full time pharmacist is more preferable.
- 4.2.3 Shall implement and ensure that standards required for pharmacy and pharmaceutical properties are maintained in high level at all times.
- 4.2.4 Shall manage and undertake all echnical and professional matters in the pharmacy.
- 4.2.5 Shall supervise and control all pharmaceutical personnel work in the pharmacy and ensure day-to-day functions of the pharmacy abide to the law.
- 4.2.6 Shall facilitate capacity building to all pharmaceutical personnel that supervises the pharmacy.
- 4.2.7 Shall provide pharmaceutical service with due care.

- 4.1.13 Shall not interfere with the performance of professional matters in the premises or cause non-performance of professional services in the pharmacy.
- 4.1.14 Shall ensure all purchases or procure nent and deliverables of pharmacy items is signed by a superintendent.
- 4.1.15 Perform any other duty as the Council may determine from time to time.

4.2 The Pharmaceutical technician

At a salary or emolument stipulated in claus 2.1.1 of this Agreement, the pharmaceutical technician shall, with all commitment and professional diligence, take the necessary steps to provide pharmaceutical care and services to clients of the said pharmacy

The pharmaceutical technician shall have the following duties and obligations: -

4.2.1 Shall provide pharmaceutical service with due care.

4.2.2 Maintain proper records and manage them in accordance to good pharmacy practice.

4.2.3 Shall keep medicines, medical suppl es and other pharmacy items are properly in compliance with good pharmacy practice

4.2.4 Shall perform any other duty as the Council may determine.

5. Termination

Unless otherwise terminated by either pa ty, this Agreement may be terminated upon expiry of the contract.

This agreement may be terminated by either party upon issuing a written notice of three (3) months to the other party of his intention to terminate this contract

The written notice shall be addressed to the other part and copy shall be submitted to the Registrar, Pharmacy Council for notification.

Notification of termination of the contract to the Registrar shall be accompanied with reasons of termination.

The Parties agree that the Council shall not be obligated to issue another notice of termination but a closure order as per the / ct.

6. Dispute Settlement

- 6.1 In the event of dispute in connection with this agreement both parties will make every effort to resolve the matter amicably. If an nicable settlement becomes impossible, then, an aggrieved party may seek legal remedy.
 - 6.2 Nothing in clause 6 (6.1) and (6.2) stall prevent the Proprietor or pharmaceutical technician from initiating or proceeding to The Commission for the Mediation and Arbitration (CMA).

7. Costs

The Proprietor shall meet the cost of drawing up this Agreement.
