"Proprietor" means an owner of Pharmacy and includes his assignees, agents or his legal representative.

"Superintendent" means a pharmacist in charge of the business of a pharmacist

"Pharmacist" means a person registered as such under section 16 of the Act.

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"Transfer of ownership" means any disposition of ownership of the facility subject of this agreement to a third party either by way of sale, lease, or any other form, which has the effect of changing or transferring power of authority of owning of pharmacy to a third person during existence of its operation

#### 4. Obligation of the Parties:

#### 4.1 The Proprietor:

The proprietor shall have the following duties and responsibilities; -

- 4.1.2 The salary/emoluments shall be net of any applicable taxes and/or deductible employment benefits and shall be paid monthly and no later than the 1<sup>st</sup>day of the following month.
- 4.1.3 Comply with the Laws, Regulations, Guidelines and standards prescribed by the Pharmacy Council and other relevant authorities.
- 4.1.4 Implement and ensure that standards required for pharmacy and pharmaceutical properties are maintained in high level at all times.
- 4.1.5 Hire other pharmaceutical personnel for providing services or dispensing personnel recognized by the Pharmacy Council.
- 4.1.6 Apply adequate funds necessary to rehabilitating or modifying the present premises and maintaining the modern pharmacy practice.
- 4.1.7 Follow up and implement on matters advised by a Superintendent on professional and matters related to provision of good pharmaceutical services.
- 4.1.8 Shall ensure pharmaceutical services are provided with due care.
- 4.1.9 Shall ensure all proper records are maintained and managed well.

- 4.1.10 Shall ensure the use of reference and other relevant materials whenever necessary for provision of pharmaceutical services and operations.
- 4.1.11. Shall report to the Pharmacy Council on poor attendance, service provided or Malpractices done by the Superintendent.
- 4.1.11 Shall purchase and ensure availability of all necessary tools for pharmacy operations are in place, i.e Superintendent Log book, PC logo, dispensing register, ledgers etc.
- 4.1.12 Shall not interfere with the performance of professional matters in the premises or cause non-performance of professional services in the pharmacy.
- 4.1.13 Shall ensure all purchases or procurement and deliverables of pharmacy items are signed by a superintendent.
- 4.1.14 Perform any other duty as the Council may determine from time to time.

# 4.2 The Superintendent;

The Superintendent pharmacist shall have the following duties and obligations: -

- 4.2.1 Shall obtain from Pharmacy council and other appropriate authorities, collect the requisite licenses, permits and authorization and keep the pharmacy within the standard and conditions as prescribed in any written law that regulate and control the pharmacy business.
- 4.2.2 Shall have overall responsibility and accountability for the maintenance and adherence to a sound system of controls in order to manage risk and promote patients safety within the pharmacy.
- 4.2.3 Shall ensure physical supervision of the said premises;
- 4.2.4 Shall ensure the pharmacy premises are of appropriate standard to provide for safe storage, dispensing, sale and supply of medical products.
- 4.2.5 Shall manage and undertake all technical and professional matters in the pharmacy.
- 4.2.6 Shall facilitate capacity building to all pharmaceutical personnel that supervises the pharmacy and ensure day-to-day function of the pharmacy business are complied with the law.
- 4.2.7 Shall ensure that all staff employed are in possession of the knowledge, skills, and competence to perform and are recognized by relevant authority.
- 4.2.8 Shall provide pharmaceutical care including information and services.

- 4.2.9 Shall ensure all proper records are maintained and managed in accordance to good pharmacy practice standards.
- 4.2.10 Shall ensure appropriate policy is in place to comply with disposal of medicinal and other products supplied in the pharmacy;
- 4.2.11 Shall ensure all availability of all necessary reference and other relevant materials necessary for provision of pharmaceutical services and operations are in place.
- 4.2.12 Shall report to the Pharmacy Council on any malpractices or violations done by the Proprietor.
- 4.2.13 Shall ensure all availability of all necessary tools for pharmacy operations are in place i.e. superintendent log book,PC logo, dispensing register, ledgers etc.;
- 4.2.14 Must ensure that whoever is on duty shall appear on a white coat and name tag on it;
- 4.2.15 Shall establish a well-organized management body of the pharmacy of which he supervise;
- 4.2.16 Shall ensure all certificates (Business permit, premise registration, copy of certificates of pharmaceutical personnel any other certificates from other are conspicuously displayed in the premises.
- 4.2.17 Shall ensure medicines, medical supplies and other pharmacy items are properly arranged and kept in compliance with good pharmacy practice standards.
- 4.2.18 Shall perform any other duty as the council may determine.

#### 5. Termination

Unless otherwise terminated by either party, this Agreement shall be terminated upon expiry of the contract.

This agreement may be terminated by mutual agreement between both parties and or any party upon issuing a written notice of three (3) months to the other party of his intention to terminate this contract

The written notice shall be addressed to the other part and copy shall be submitted to the Registrar, Pharmacy Council for notification.

Notification of termination of the contract to the Registrar shall be accompanied with reasons of termination.

The Parties agree that the Council shall not be obligated to issue another notice of termination but a closure order as per the Act.

#### 6. Dispute Settlement

- 6.1 In the event of dispute in connection with this agreement both parties will make every effort to resolve the matter amicably.
- 6.2 If amicable settlement becomes impossible, then, an aggrieved party may seek legal remedy.
- 6.3 Nothing in clause 6 (6.1) and (6.2) shall prevent the Proprietor or Pharmaceutical Technician from initiating or proceeding to The Commission for the Mediation and Arbitration (CMA).

#### 7. Costs

The Proprietor shall meet the cost of drawing up this Agreement.

- The laws of Tanzania hereto shall govern the validity, construction and interpretation of this agreement and the rights and duties of the parties.
- The Pharmacy Council will accept additional clauses but this Agreement is a generic contract for guidance only.
